# Corner-to-Corner Crochet Baby Blanket

Description: A simple crochet stitch results in a series blocks crocheted from corner-to-corner. Add interest with a variegated or self-striping yarn.

Finished size: Approximately 30" square

#### Materials:

• Yarn: Painted Mist (by Knitting Fever)

o 3 balls (820 yds)

• Hook: H/8 (5mm)

Abbreviations:

ch: chain

dc: double crochet sl st: slip stitch

ch-3 sp: chain-3 space previously made



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#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

- Ch 6.
- Row 1. (RS) 1 dc in 4<sup>th</sup> ch from hook (counts as ch-3 and dc). 1 dc in each of next 2 ch. Turn. 1 block made
- Row 2. Ch 6, 1 dc in 4<sup>th</sup> ch from hook. 1 dc in each of next 2 ch (*Beg block made*). Skip next 3 dc. (sl st, ch 3, 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp. (*Block made*).
- Turn. (2 blocks made).
- Row 3. Beg block. (Block) twice. Turn. 3 blocks.
- Row 4. Beg block. (Block) 3 times. Turn. 4 blocks.
- Row 5. Beg block. (Block) 4 times. Turn. 5 blocks.
- Continue increasing 1 block each row, as established, until left side from beg measures 30", or the desired width.
- Begin decreasing:
- Next row: SI st in each of next 3 dc. Block in each ch-3 sp to last ch-3 sp. SI st in last ch-3 sp. Turn.
- Repeat last row until 1 block remains.
- Fasten off.
