



Yin-Yang Infinity Scarf

Materials List

Two skeins of yarn in co-ordinating colors.

Yarn weight and crochet hook of your choosing.

Gauge is not important for this project, so adjust the hook size to your preference.

The sample was made with a cotton/wool sport weight yarn.

I used approximately 115 yards of each color . My finished size was 5.5" x 88", but this can be made in any size that suits your needs.

Hook used in the sample was a 6.5mm (K), but I tend to be a tight crocheter, so adjust accordingly.



This pattern is a simple two row repeat.

Work as many rows as needed to desired length.



Stiches used:

Chain and double crochet.

Shell = 5 dc in same stitch.

To Begin: Chain 19.

<p>Row 1</p>	<p>Work 4 dc in the 4th chain from the hook.</p> <p>Skip 4 chains, work 5 dc in the next chain (shell made).</p> <p>Repeat 1 time. Work 3 dc in the last chain.</p> <p>Chain 3 (counts as dc), turn.</p>	<p>Stitch count</p> <p>17 dc.</p>
<p>Row 2</p>	<p>Work 4 dc in the first dc (shell made). Work 5 dc (shell) in the 3rd dc of the next shell. Repeat until you reach the last shell. Work 3 dc in the 3rd dc of the last shell.</p> <p>Chain 3 (counts as dc), turn.</p>	<p>18 dc.</p>
<p>Row 3 to center.</p>	<p>Repeat Row 2 until the scarf is half of the desired length.</p>	<p>18 dc.</p>
<p>Center to end.</p>	<p>Attach the second color and continue to work Row 2 until you've equaled the rows of the first color.</p> <p>Make sure you leave enough yarn from the second skein to whip stitch the ends together.</p>
